Bump on the Head

Dear Parent / Carer,

Your child has had an accident at school today.

He/She received a bump to the head. He/She was seen and treated by a qualified first aider. She/he is well and being observed the rest of the school day.

However, it is important that you watch for any signs or symptoms in your child which might indicate a more serious injury.

Please keep in mind that these symptoms can develop days or even weeks after the accident.

PLEASE WATCH FOR:

- Drowsiness that is unexpected
- Dizziness
- Vomiting
- Any signs of blood or watery fluid coming from the nose or ears
- Any complaint of a headache
- Any complaint of `seeing double` or `blurred eye sight`

If any of these signs develop, then you should contact your doctor for further advice.
