You may have heard a lot in the media about safety concerns regarding school buildings and the use of Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC).

The DfE has been helping education settings and responsible bodies (such as local authorities and multi-academy trusts) to identify and manage the potential risks of RAAC since 2018. You can find more in the Education Hub article published by DfE.

We appreciate the concern this may raise, and we will always prioritise the safety of your children and our staff.

We do not have any confirmed RAAC in our buildings and have not been asked to close any areas.

The change in guidance is precautionary in nature, and only affects education premises where the presence of RAAC has been confirmed.
