
School Money

Last term we informed you that, in response to parents and carers requests, we now have the facility for you to make payments for school expenses, such as breakfasts, lunches and school trips, online with your debit or credit card.

As well as being more convenient for you, you will also be able to access your account at any time to see what has been paid and what is due.

You have been automatically signed up to this system by the school as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details. You should have your password by now but if you do not, please contact the school office. This password will give you access to your SchoolMoney account where you can pay for any items we have requested from you. Instructions to log on have been sent to you. If you need another copy or require some help with this, again, please speak to the school office. We will be holding workshops soon to support you to use this cashless system.
